## Are Your Bottles A Pain In The Glass?



According to a recent study by the State of Ohio, over 12,000 pounds of glass is generated by a typical bar/restaurant annually.

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency estimates that close to 90% of glass in the state ends up at a landfill.

The Shelby County Recycling Center, Shelby County Commissioners, the North Central Ohio Solid Waste District and the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency have partnered together to help recover glass from Shelby County that would otherwise end up in landfills.



Bars and Restaurants in Shelby County are encouraged to bring their recyclable glass bottles to the recycling center at 1600 Riverside Drive (W. St. Rte. 47), Sidney.

A convenient **GLASS DROP-OFF** area (See Map Below) is available Monday through Friday 8 AM to 4 PM, where all your Glass Beverage Bottles can be brought to be properly recycled.
